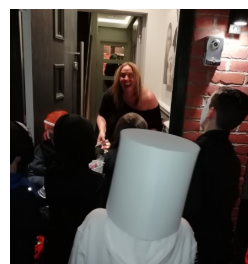


Hallowe'en Fun!
