Planning Updates The planning application for agricultural buildings with a new access off Warrington Rd. opposite Hatton Lodge Cottages has been approved by the Borough Council.

Warrington Local Plan The latest version of the new Local Plan for Warrington has been paused until mid-2021 so that the Borough Council can decide if it needs to be changed. A group of South Warrington Parish Councils of which Hatton Parish Council is an active member was set up to question the proposed Local Plan particularly on the subject of loss of green belt. The group has now suggested a significant revision of the Plan partly due to the pandemic and changes in Government planning policy. It proposes an alternative vision for the future development of Warrington focused more on the town centre and future transport improvements. . An online presentation of this open to members of the public held on October 27th at 6.30pm via Zoom.. Advertised locally and in the press.

New House Farm Planning Application The original Planning Application for 31 houses has been amended and has now been resubmitted to Warrington BC. The main changes relate to the layout particularly the internal road system and some of the outside areas. The number of houses remains the same **There will be no childrens play area but a community orchard is proposed. Full information can be seen on the Borough Council website planning section using the reference 2020/36311.** The Parish Council previously submitted an Objection Statement after views of villagers were taken into account and two well attended meetings had been held. It is likely that the objection will remain but no decision has yet been made as the consultation period runs until 11th November. A number of adjacent residents also have been consulted and it will be recalled that anyone can submit their views to the Borough Council. If you wish to pass your views to the Parish Council please contact any Parish Councillor.
