Hatton Car Park – Recycling Bins

Warrington Borough Council have removed the recycling bins from Hatton Car Park. A representative from the Borough Council attended the site and an inspection was made of both bins, it was found that the bins were being used by people from outside of the borough and trade organisations, contrary to regulations. The Council also questioned how both bins were being filled so quickly, commenting that Hatton is a small village with every household having a blue recycling bin.

The cardboard and clothes bins are not affected and will stay in situ, however the Council will be monitoring the area more closely over the coming months.

Creamfields 2021

The Parish Council, through the Chair Paul Molphy, have been in contact with the organisers of the festival and asked specific questions of them. They have confirmed that they are working with the Government on the DCMS Event Research Program, delivering a number of small, and large-scale events, producing data that will hopefully result in the eventual lifting of all COVID related restrictions across the UK. This is their response to the questions posed:

Will the normal liaison activities be taking place prior to the festival?

We would normally by now have held at least one consultation meeting with the Residents Committee, but for obvious reasons this has not happened. We would like to set up a Zoom meeting as we are keen to continue to consult with the Residents Committee and the Parish Councillors.

What additional COVID 19 prevention measures will be in place to protect residents?

Working with DCMS Event Research Program and Public Health England we have developed a set of guidelines that will be used at all major events throughout the UK. This covers anyone who attends or comes into contact with the events. We plan to talk through this guidance during the meeting with the Residents Committee.

Will residents receive their usual benefits?

In terms of tickets and car passes, we see no reason why not, we will give an update at the meeting with the Residents Committee.
