



## **Hatton PC News – Creamfields 2021 August 27<sup>th</sup> – 30<sup>th</sup>**

The Parish Council have informed the head of the external Creamfields security operation about shortcomings observed on Thursday, and they are being investigated.

Creamfields advise that Security patrol the perimeter of the site in vehicles and there are 6 patrol/ response teams active at any time. The Creamfields staff manning various locations are mostly Traffic Marshals. Warrington Road is planned to remain open to non-festival traffic this year with Marshals redirecting any waifs and strays. Previous traffic cones set up has been decided against by WBC during traffic planning, apparently it can create dangerous/ frustrating traffic build ups, as was reported Thursday afternoon.

The Warrington Road car park for early campers will now be full, so all festival traffic will be directed to the South car parks off Daresbury lane, via the Daresbury official access route, meaning Hatton shouldn't experience festival related traffic from tomorrow onwards. The only potential situation for Friday is a 'relief valve' protocol, if traffic backs up to the A56 some will be marshalled via Summer/ Pilmoss Lane round to Daresbury Lane. The Warrington Road car park vehicles will be directed out via Park Lane splash on Monday.

The Parish Council remain in close contact with Festival Security and Event Organisers. All issues will be reinforced during debrief sessions so that they can be fed into future planning.

## **Ultra-Fast Broadband in Hatton??**

Although subject to approval this will require residents to show their commitment to signing up to an Ultra-Fast Broadband service. You will therefore be canvassed, in the near future, to show your commitment as a strong majority is required to make this possible.
