Designation of Conservation Areas

“ Created where the LPA identifies an are of special architectural or historic interest which deserves careful management to protect their character”

Designation of Conservation Areas

- The centres of our historic villages, towns and cities
- Fishing and mining villages
- 18th, 19th and 20th-century suburbs
- Model housing estates, including late 20th century housing projects
- Country houses set in their historic parks
- Historic transport links and their environs, such as stretches of canal and railway and airfields
- Industrial heritage sites





Designation of Conservation Areas

Additional controls

- Limitation of usually applied permitted development rights.
- Testing development proposals against the significance of a heritage asset and the degree of harm resulting from development

Designation of Conservation Areas

NPPF Paragraph 191

When considering designation of conservation areas, local planning authorities should ensure that an area justifies such status because of special architectural or historic interest, and that the concept of conservation is not devalued through the designation of areas that lack special interest
