Ultra-Fast Fibre Optic Broadband in Hatton

Whilst we had hoped to have received the decision on Government approval for the funding by now, due to an extremely large number of requests, the process has been delayed. We are doing all we can to raise its priority and hope to have some news soon. Remember that should the approval be granted everyone who registered will be asked, via email, to confirm their commitment before it can move forward. Fingers crossed!!

Neighbourhood Plans

In our last edition we mentioned that John Groves of Groves Town Planning had given a presentation to the Parish Council on Conservation Areas. He also covered Neighbourhood Developments Plans and whether one would be appropriate for Hatton. At the present time the Parish Council do not intend to pursue such a Plan. Warrington Local Plan

The consultation period on the latest draft Local Plan finished on 15th November. A copy of the joint response on behalf of the six South Warrington Parish Councils (also prepared by John Groves in consultation with Parish Council representatives) has been put on the Hatton Village website. It is interesting to note that possible changes to planning rules by the Government may lead to changes to the Plan which as proposed affects some 1000 acres of Greenbelt in south Warrington although no land in Hatton is directly affected.
