Ultra-Fast Fibre Optic Broadband in Hatton is *GO*

The funding vouchers for the Ultra-Fast Fibre Optic Broadband for Hatton have at last been fully approved by the Government! This is great news as it will ensure that our Village will not be left behind in the modern world of Internet connectivity and will place us among the very best in the country.

We will now work with Openreach on the delivery of the network, and at some point, all individuals who pledged their intention to subscribe will be asked by DCMS/Openreach to confirm their position, so each funding voucher can be redeemed. This will not occur until the project is ready to go and we will keep you informed on this.

However, we will shortly be emailing everyone who also confirmed that they have a business at their address to request some basic company details. This is simply something that Openreach require for the verification process so please look out for this.

Village Gates – Hatton Lane

Warrington Borough Council have now moved the 'Village Gates' on Hatton Lane to the correct boundary location. The Parish Council are consulting with Warrington Borough Council with regard to speed signage along Hatton Lane. It is planned that WBC will erect a post, to which a Vehicle Activated Speed sign (provided by the Parish Council), will be placed along the 30mph section of Hatton Lane. It is hoped, that together with this and the speed enforcement patrols, it will go some way to ensuring that speed limits are adhered to.
