## **Hatton Resident Receives Queen's Platinum Jubilee Medal Award**

A huge 'Well Done' to **Anthony Horrigan of Gosling Close**, who is a member of Cheshire Search and Rescue Team (last year's recipients from the Hatton Fun Day). Anthony has been very honoured to receive the Queen's Platinum Jubilee Medal for Emergency Services, in recognition for time served as a volunteer at Cheshire Search and Rescue Team.

This, highly prestigious, award is given to hundreds of volunteers in recognition of their service in searching for and rescuing missing people in lowland areas. This is the first time that Lowland Rescue Members have been included for individual medals, alongside the other major UK Search and Rescue volunteer organisations such as Mountain Rescue and Cave Rescue.
