As you may have noticed by the regular OpenReach presence in the village, the Ultra-Fast Full Fibre Broadband project is actively in progress. Although it is still officially in the survey stage, it is now reported to be awaiting the build estimates to come back from planning so watch this space!

<u>Planning</u>

Application for Proposed Agricultural Building

Planning application 2022/42165, for a proposed agricultural building at New House Farm has been refused on the grounds that the proposed building is located on land identified by an earlier planning application (2020/36311), as being in equestrian use. Permitted development rights for the erection of agricultural buildings do not exist.

Local Plan

The Examination in Public has taken place and South Warrington Parishes Group have employed a planning consultant and specialist barrister to put their views to the Government Inspector. A decision is anticipated in a few months' time.
