Update on Village Defibrillator

The Parish Council took steps in late 2017 to place a defibrillator in the telephone box at the Hatton Arms. It was established with the support of the Community Heartbeat Trust. We have maintained that partnership over the years and we are able to purchase batteries and pads from them when the use by date expires. If we ever need a replacement defibrillator on a temporary basis then they would supply one. From the time of setting up our defibrillator in the phone box we have been linked to the NW Ambulance Service.

With the welcomed increase in the number of defibrillators across the country the local database at the NW Ambulance Service (NWAS) has now been replaced by a single national defibrillator database called 'The Circuit'. All existing defibrillators are required to transfer to The Circuit and ours is registered with this network. The defibrillator is available and allocated to NWAS 999 calls in the same manner as previously. We will still maintain our partnership with the Community Heartbeat Trust to ensure we are able to keep the equipment emergency ready. Regular site visits to check the equipment are reported through their website.
