### Creamfields

Creamfields Meeting took place on Thursday 10th August.

2. Attached Leaflet from Creamfields with information highlighting complaints procedure.
3. Security (new company) will be as last year but if you have requests/ issues for your home/business which are new please contact via hotline/email above asap.
4. Resident passes will be posted out as previously however the Residents Liaison Officer (new one this year) will be at Walton Village Hall on Tuesday 22nd August 6pm till 7pm to give out additional passes.
5. New Festival Director this year. Jess had been involved for a number of years up until 2016 so has some experience of the event.
6. Police will be in position to stop scavengers on Warrington Rd on Bank Holiday Monday.
7. The Marshalls will stay in position on the Tuesday after Bank Holiday Monday this year so keep your resident passes past the Monday.
8. Cat and Lion will be manned in order to stop traffic other than residents and those requiring access to businesses.
9. Cream will now clear the site from the outer edges of the site first rather than from the centre. Hopefully this will help on litter blowing and less for scavengers to access easily from the roadside.

11. Number of staff on Creamfields hotline has been doubled from 1 to 2. There will also be 2 local people which should help in case staff have no local knowledge.

### **Hatton Arms Voucher – Creamfields Weekend**

The Parish Council have decided, in coordination with the Hatton Arms, to provide villagers with a voucher which can be redeemed at the Hatton arms during the weekend of Creamfields.

The Parish Council will provide each adult with a £10 voucher and children with a £5 voucher. In order to receive your voucher, you should email Jayne Power

Your email should include, your address and the names of the residents applying for a voucher and whether they are adults or children. The deadline for applications is **Friday 18<sup>th</sup> August 2023**, vouchers cannot be applied for after this date.

You will then receive the appropriate vouchers directly to your address week commencing **21<sup>st</sup> August 2023**.

The following terms apply to the use of your vouchers:

- The voucher can only be redeemed as follows:  
**Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> August 12.00 – 8.30pm**  
**Friday 25<sup>th</sup> August 12.00 – 8.30pm**  
**Saturday 26<sup>th</sup> August 12.00 - 8.30pm**  
**Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> August 12.00 – 8.30pm**  
**Monday 28<sup>th</sup> August 12.00 – 7.00pm**
- The voucher can only be redeemed against **Food and Drink** and a table **must** be booked.
- You **must** produce the original voucher on the day, unfortunately if this is not provided the voucher cannot be honoured.
- The vouchers **cannot** be redeemed at any other time and will be void after the dates stated.
- The vouchers can only be redeemed by the person the voucher was issued to, every voucher will be numbered and linked to the address that it was claimed from. The Hatton Arms will hold a list of all issued vouchers.
